An Ordinance to Establish Storm Water Management and Water Quality Controls, Programs, Regulations, Prohibitions and Penalties for Shelby County

Shelby County Ordinance No. 98-09-28-8:

**Section 01-020. General Requirements for Land Disturbance
Activities.**

(g) Erosion and sediment control measures must be in place and functional before earth moving operations begin, and must be constructed and maintained throughout the construction period as necessary. Temporary measures may be removed at the beginning of the workday, but shall be replaced at the end of the workday.

BUILDING INSPECTIONS WILL BE WITHHELD:

If periodic inspections, conducted by Shelby County personnel, determine that erosion or sediment controls are not in-place or are not being maintained on the construction site in accordance with the above requirements.
