## VINTAGE VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

### VEHICLE PURCHASED FROM A DEALER:

- Title Application if the vehicle is less than 35 years
- Dealership Bill of Sale Including:
  - Year
  - Make
  - Model
  - VIN
  - Date of Sale
  - Purchase Price
  - Sales Tax Breakdown by State, County and City
  - Buyer's Name(s) and Address
  - Buyer and Seller's Signature(s)

\*\*\* If a vehicle is traded that information needs to be listed on the bill of sale\*\*\*

- Valid Driver's License or State Issued ID of Buyer(s)- The Name(s) on the Paperwork must match the Name(s) on the IDs.
- Proof of Alabama Insurance on this vehicle
- Proof of Residency if you are new to Shelby County- Utility Bill, Lease Agreement or Property Deed in your name. If you are living with someone a Notarized Residency Affidavit needs to be completed by the property owner.
- VIN Inspection- If the vehicle was purchased out of state the vehicle has to be brought to the DMV or bring a COMPLETED VIN Inspection Form by an Alabama Officer
- Application for Vintage Vehicle License Plates- Completed at License Office

### VEHICLE PURCHASED FROM AN INDIVIDUAL:

- Notarized Bill of Sale Including:
  - Year
  - Make
  - Model
  - VIN
  - Date of Sale
  - Purchase Price
  - Buyer and Seller's Printed Name(s)
  - Buyer and Seller's Address
  - Buyer and Seller's Signature(s)

\*\*\*Alterations of any kind VOIDS the Bill of Sale\*\*\*

- Ownership document from seller- current registration or insurance card
- Valid Driver's License or State Issued ID of Buyer(s)- The Name(s) on the Bill of Sale must match the Name(s) on the IDs.
- Proof of Alabama Insurance on this vehicle
- Proof of Residency-please see residency requirements listed above
- VIN Inspection- If the vehicle was purchased out of state the vehicle has to be brought to the DMV or bring a COMPLETED VIN Inspection Form by an Alabama Officer
- Application for Vintage License Plates- Completed at License Office

How to determine if the vehicle is eligible for a vintage vehicle license plate:  
October 1 is considered as the beginning of a new model year for vehicles registered as Vintage.  
For Example: On October 1, 2024, a 1995 vehicle will qualify for a vintage license plate.
