SCRJDF continues to make progress though prevention of sexual abuse and sexual harassment through the designation of a PREA Coordinator, supervision and monitoring, criminal background checks, staff training, resident education, PREA posters and educational materials. The facility detects sexual abuse and sexual harassment through resident education, staff training, and intake screening for risk of sexual victimization and abuse. The SCRJDF responds to sexual abuse and sexual harassment through various ways of reporting, investigations, disciplinary sanctions for residents and staff, victim advocacy, access to emergency medical treatment and crisis intervention services, sexual abuse incident reviews, data collection, and data review for corrective action.

There were no allegations from detainees and therefore no corrective actions were taken.
